At the start of the meeting, Member Secretary-AC Dr. S. P. Mohani and Chairman-AC and Principal Dr. R. D. Kokate welcomed honorable members of Academic Council (AC). With the permission of chairman-AC, the proceeding of the AC meeting started.

Item No 1:

To read and confirm the minutes of tenth (10th) meeting of Academic Council held in the meeting hall of institute on **Saturday**, **July 20**; **2019** at **10.00** am.

- 1.1 The tenth meeting of Academic Council was held in the meeting hall of institute on 20.07.2019 at 10.30 a.m. in the meeting hall of the institute. Its minutes were circulated among all honorable AC members on 30.07.2019.
 - (AC-10 MoM were shared with AC members in online mode.)
- 1.2 The Minutes (MoM) of $10^{\rm th}$ meeting were read in the meeting. Academic Council noted it and confirmed the same without any modification.

Item No 2:

To note and approve the action taken by the institute on the agenda points discussed and resolved in the earlier meetings of Academic Council.

- 2.1 The tenth meeting of Academic Council was held on 20.07.2019 at 10.30 a.m. in the meeting hall of institute. Member Secretary-AC, Dr. Mohani informed the AC members that the institute has taken actions as per the decisions taken by Academic Council in that meeting.
- 2.2 Academic Council noted and approved the same.

Item No. 3:

To discuss and approve the examination result policy for summer 2020 session for first year, second year and third year courses in view of COVID-19 situation.

3.1 Due to COVID-19 situation, the result declaration for first year, second year and third year courses and first year M. Tech. is required to be done without conduction of End Semester Examination and the examination result policy is framed as per guidelines from UGC,

Government of Maharashtra (GoM) and KBC North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon. Dean Academics presented the examination result policy of the institute to the AC members.

(Examination result policy of the institute was shared with AC members in online mode.)

3.2 Academic Council discussed the examination result policy, and approved it without any modification.

Item No. 4:

To authorize the AC chairman to decide regarding result declaration policy for fourth year B. Tech. students in accordance with state government policy (to be announced).

- 4.1 Member secretary AC informed that the policy for conduction / non-conduction of final year B. Tech. and M. Tech. examination is not yet announced by the Government of Maharashtra and requested the AC members to authorize the AC chairman for decision regarding result declaration policy for final year B. Tech. / M. Tech. students after the state government policy is declared.
- 4.2 The AC members unanimously authorized the AC chairman for decision regarding result declaration policy for final year B. Tech. / M. Tech. students after the state government policy is declared.

Item No. 5:

To authorize the AC chairman to decide about conduction of supplementary examination for backlog courses after normalization of COVID-19 situation as per state government guidelines.

- 5.1 For those students who have failed in any of the courses, a special single supplementary examination will be conducted (instead of two separate examinations Summer Re-exam and Complementary examination) for all theory and lab courses of even and odd semester in the month of October / November 2020 (tentatively) after COVID situation normalizes. In view of this, member secretary AC requested the AC members to authorize the AC chairman for decision about conduction of supplementary examination for backlog courses after normalization of COVID-19 situation as per state government guidelines.
- 5.2 The AC members unanimously authorized the AC chairman for decision about conduction of supplementary examination for backlog courses after normalization of COVID-19 situation as per state government guidelines.

Item No. 6:

To discuss and approve the extension of one more year for students who have

- 1 completed three years after admission and still not cleared First Year courses.
- 2. completed six years after admission and have not yet completed B.Tech. degree. (This is in view of COVID-19 situation)
- 6.1 As per the institute rules, the student has to pass the first year within 3 years after admission, B. Tech in maximum of 6 years and M. Tech. in maximum of 4 years after admission. The ESE examinations (Summer, Summer Re-exam, and Complementary exam) were not conducted in Summer-2020 session (due to COVID-19 situation).

6.2 In view of this, the AC members discussed and approved the extension of one academic year for such students in all the cases, due to COVID-19 situation.

Item No 7:

To authorize AC chairman to decide and approve the academic calendar of the institute for academic year 2020 - 21 (in view of COVID-19 situation).

- 7.1 In view of COVID-19 situation and the uncertainty of normalcy for academics to commence, the academic calendar for the academic year 2020-21 will be prepared after the normalcy is restored. (The date of commencement of teaching for existing students of the institute is declared as 16^{th} August, 2020 and for newly admitted students as 15^{th} September, 2020 by AICTE recently.) In view of this, member secretary-AC requested the AC members to authorize AC chairman to decide and approve the academic calendar of the institute for academic year 2020 21.
- 7.2 The AC members unanimously authorized the AC chairman for decision about finalizing and approving the academic calendar for the academic year 2020-21, as per the COVID-19 situation and state government guidelines.

Item No 8:

To discuss and approve modifications (if any) in the autonomy / examination rules of the institute.

8.1 In the 10th meeting of Examination committee (EC), a modification was approved in Autonomy Rule 14.8 regarding eligibility for make-up examination related to medical and sports cases.

(Modified Rule – Make-up exam was shared with AC members in online mode)

Member secretary – AC explained the modification regarding eligibility for make-up examination related to medical and sports cases.

8.2 Academic Council suggested to include 'intercollegiate sports at University level' words and approved the modification in autonomy rule 14.8 regarding eligibility for make-up examination related to medical and sports cases.

Item No 9:

To discuss and approve modifications (if any) in the curriculum structure and detailed syllabus of third year of B. Tech. (Mechanical Engineering) Program and curriculum structure of new M. Tech. Program recommended by BoS - Mechanical Engineering.

- 9.1 The syllabus of third year B. Tech. of revised curriculum was discussed and approved (with suggestions) by Departmental Faculty Board (DFB), respective Board of Studies (BoS) and Academic Program Evaluation Committee (APEC) of the institute. It was presented in this meeting for final approval of Academic Council (AC) by Chairperson BoS Mechanical Engineering.
 - (Mechanical Syllabus (TY and M. Tech) was shared with AC members in online mode)
- 9.2 For the new M. Tech. program, there may be certain modifications in the syllabus and/or the Page 6 of 9

- structure as per the requirement. In view of this, AC was requested to authorize AC chairman to approve the same, if suggested by BoS chairperson.
- 9.3 The AC members discussed the third year and M. Tech. syllabus of Mechanical Engineering and approved the same with few suggestions. Also, the AC members authorized the AC chairman for approval of modifications in the M. Tech. structure and/or syllabus if suggested by concerned BoS chairperson.

Item No 10:

To discuss and approve modifications (if any) in the curriculum structure and detailed syllabus of third year of B. Tech. (Electronics and Telecommunication) Program recommended by BoS - Electronics and Telecommunication.

- 10.1 The syllabus of third year B. Tech. of revised curriculum was discussed and approved (with suggestions) by Departmental Faculty Board (DFB), respective Board of Studies (BoS) and Academic Program Evaluation Committee (APEC) of the institute. It was presented in this meeting for final approval of Academic Council (AC) by Chairperson BoS –Electronics and Telecommunication Engineering.
